Section 3. Conditions

- 3.1 QUTBS agrees in principle to accept applications from Master of Business Administration (International Management) MBA(IM) students of FJCUCM for admission to specified majors within the QUTBS Master of Business (International Business) – Advanced subject to their meeting the following criteria:
- (i) Completion of a recognised Bachelor’s degree plus at least 32 credit hours of study, as specified in attachment 1, in the MBA(IM) at FJCUCM;
 - (ii) A minimum grade point average (GPA) of 2.75 on a 4.0 scale for the specific study at FJCUCM as provided in attachment 3.
 - (iii) English proficiency: Meet the usual English language requirements of QUT as provided in attachment 3.

Section 7. Financial Arrangements

- 7.1 Students will be subject to the statutes, rules and policies of QUT over the time that they are enrolled at QUT. This includes covering the standard QUT enrolment and tuition fees for this period.

Application Procedures

There is no closing date for applications for the Master of Business programs; however students are required to finalise their acceptance and arrive at QUT on time for classes. Students are also strongly advised to allow for sufficient time for visa application. Hence, it is suggested that applications for admission are submitted four months prior to commencement of the course. Commencement dates for each semester are available on the QUT website at

A non-refundable application fee of AUD\$55 is normally required from all applicants although this fee is waived if the application is received via FJUCM. To facilitate application processing, FJCU sends applications for each intake to QUT in a batch to teama@qut.edu.au. International Student Application forms (F forms) are processed on receipt and the successful applicants are made an offer for the next available intake. Conditional offers can be made on results available at the time of application. Offers are confirmed after receipt of the final results.

For FJCU students, unconditional offers can be made based on the completion of the first semester of the program at FJCU.

Minimum Entry Requirements
