ARTICLE 2

IMPLEMENTATION OF COOPERATION

2. The teaching at each university will be conducted in English. In order to gain admission, students will be required to satisfy the English Language Proficiency Requirements as determined by each university for post graduate admission and as amended from time to time. Listed below are the current minimum requirements for each accepted English Language Test. Students must satisfy ONE of the following the minimum English proficiency requirements:

TOEIC: 750 or IELTS: 6.0 or TOEFL: 80

- 3. At the time of application, the student must meet all admission requirements of SolBridge and FJCM, and provide an official transcript from their university. In order to gain admission, students will also be required to satisfy the minimum academic requirement:
 - b. For applicants from FJCM: study at the imMBA and complete the required courses specified in Attachment 1 (32 credits in total) and reach a satisfactory performance level (minimum 70 on a scale from 0 to 100), and complete a master's thesis and fulfill all the requirements of thesis at Fu Jen Catholic University.
- 4. Both parties agree to inform their students, that they have responsibility for the following financial costs upon completion of the program including, but not be limited to:
 - (a) Applicable tuition fees at both institutions for students from FJCM;
 - (b) Travel arrangement expenses;
 - (c) Accommodation and living expenses;
 - (d) Insurance, medical, or associated expenses due to illness or injury; and
 - (e) Teaching materials expenses.
