President's Scholarship Regulations

Article 1: Purpose of Establishment

This policy is formulated to reward and attract outstanding international students (excluding students from Hong Kong, Macau, Mainland China, and overseas Chinese students) to enroll in the MBA Program in International Management (hereinafter referred to as imMBA) at Fu Jen Catholic University.

Article 2: Funding Source

The scholarship comes from the university's internal budget and is allocated annually by the imMBA program for execution.

Article 3: Eligibility for Application

New international students enrolled in the IMBA program during their admission semester who meet one of the following conditions are eligible to receive a scholarship of NT\$40,600 per semester for up to four consecutive semesters. If a student takes a leave of absence or discontinues their studies, they are considered to have forfeited the scholarship:

1. The applicant holds citizenship from an English-speaking country or a country where English is an official language.
2. The applicant has achieved a TOEFL iBT, IELTS, or TOEIC score equivalent to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) B2 level or above (scores must be valid within two years prior to admission). Students who achieve the required score after enrollment will become eligible for the scholarship from the approval date onward, and retroactive awards will not be granted.

Students receiving the Government Scholarships or FJCU Scholarships for New International Students in Master's Degree Programs are not eligible to apply for this scholarship.

Article 4 - Required Documents and Application Deadline

Proof of eligibility as specified in Article 3 must be submitted to the imMBA Office one week before the start of the semester.

Article 5 - Disbursement Method

This scholarship is a one-time award. Upon approval of the application submitted to the imMBA Office, the scholarship will be directly deducted from tuition and fees. The recipients will also be publicly recognized by FJCU President.

In the event of any discrepancies between the Chinese and English versions, the Chinese version shall prevail.
