

Graduation Requirements

MBA Program in International Management (imMBA)

Fu Jen Catholic University

Article I: imMBA graduation requirements are listed as follows

1. Complete 23 credits of required courses:
11 credits from absolutely required courses, including thesis 6 credits; 12 credits from optionally required courses.
2. Complete 19 credits of elective courses.
3. Complete the final thesis defense.
4. The minimum credit for graduation is 42 credits.

Article II: English graduation requirement

1. Students must meet CEFR B2 or above (TOEIC 785+, TOEFL iBT 72+, or IELTS 6.0+). Only scores obtained within two years before graduation are valid. Students who do not meet the requirement must provide proof of taking at least one English proficiency test during enrollment and complete two approved English enhancement courses with a score of 70 or above. These courses do not count toward graduation credits.
2. Students may be exempt if, upon enrollment, they:
 - already hold a valid English proficiency test score at CEFR B2 level or above obtained within the previous two years;
 - receive a Presidential Scholarship; or
 - within five years prior to enrollment, have completed at least two years of full-time study in professional courses taught in English at a recognized university in the US, UK, Ireland, Australia, New Zealand, Canada, or South Africa (excluding language training programs). Students are responsible for providing relevant transcripts and supporting documents.

Article III: Course regulation

1. Economics, Business Management, Statistics, and Accounting are imMBA prerequisite courses. Students who did not take or failed these courses during their undergraduate studies need to complete and pass 1 of the aforementioned courses before the end of the first semester in the first year of enrollment. The chosen prerequisite course can't be counted towards graduation credits.

2. Only courses from the College of Management which are graduate-level, English conducted, business-related could be counted towards graduation credits. Otherwise, students should ask the imMBA director for approval before course registration.
3. Except for the very last semester of study or the consent from the imMBA director, all students in the first year need to take 9-18 credits per semester, and 8-18 credits per semester in the second year.

Article IV: The final thesis defense

1. Only those who meet the course and English requirements outlined above are eligible to apply for the master's thesis final defense.
2. Students must publicly present and pass the first three chapters of their thesis before applying for the master's thesis final defense. The first three-chapter presentation and the master's thesis final defense should apart at least three months.
3. When applying for the master's thesis final defense, students must submit relevant supporting documents and provide a written affidavit. If the contents of the affidavit are violated, the master's thesis final defense will be invalid.
4. The final thesis defense includes the defense, the score, and the thesis revision. Only all three parts are passed and approved by the thesis advisor and the score sent to the Office of Academic Affairs will the defense complete.
